The doers. The <u>first verses</u> of chapters 3, 7, 10, 11, 12 of Nehemiah list the doers' names and the ways they served. Explain why a good leader knows it is important to recognize those who serve, including those who serve in what appear to be lesser jobs.

Residence, <u>v. 11:1-2</u>. Notice how it was determined who would live in Jerusalem and rebuild the city. Speculate upon how this might apply in the church today.

Serving. Each of us serves God in ministry. Consider what motivates our service and the significance of our service in our overall goal of reaching people in Houston and the world.

Low profile service. Take a moment to think about the many ministries that take place among us and those who help make them happen. Be mindful of specific people who are in "low profile" roles and thank them for their service to God and this community of believers.
