Considerations for the week

History. The history of the people of God tells us a lot about the nature of God, as does the personal history of an individual. Relate your thoughts on the histories of old and of the present-day, and how these give us insight into the nature of God.

Sorrow, v. 1-5. Notice particularly how the people expressed sorrow for their sin. They worked at it. Consider each of their inward and outward means of expression. Draw parallels with your own experience and other current-day expressions of sorrow.

Nature of God, v. 6-37. What is said about the nature of God and His character? Attributes mentioned include: creator, covenant-maker, compassionate, law-maker, forgiver, consequence-giver, rescuer, covenant-keeper, provider, faithful.

Prosperity. Discuss how the times of plenty and the times of difficulty affected the spiritual life of Israel and of us.

Are you a thankful person? How do you know you are? How do other people know? How does God know? How might you become more thankful?

Please use these considerations for personal reflection, small group discussions, and with friends and family.
