Considerations for the week

When challenged by someone about how God can love the world when there is so much violence and death here, how might we respond?

Take note of how John speaks of eternal life elsewhere (e.g., John 17:3, 14:6, 10:27-28, 20:30-31; 1 John 5:11-13). How does that deepen your understanding of this verse?

How is biblical belief different than mere intellectual agreement?

What is the difference between eternal life as a future promise and eternal life as a present reality?

In what ways might John 3:16 reshape the way we view people who are far from faith?

In your experience with matters of coming to Christ – either in your own salvation or in speaking with others of salvation – what verses of the gospel message have been prominent?

Plan now to take a moment each day this week to re-read John 3:16 with fresh eyes, as though you've never heard it. Each time, be sure to give yourself leave to allow it to challenge you personally.

Please use these considerations for personal reflection, small group discussions, and with friends and family.
