Theological points from the text	Consider the sense in which we were each formerly enemies of God. What are the consequences of being His enemy? Describe why one needs to be reconciled with God.
	Reconciled, v. 22. Define the terms used to describe our new condition. How does this transformation impact our relationship with God and others?
Declaring war on God and the peace provided <u>Romans 8:28-39</u>	Persevering, v. 23. Our reconciliation is to be followed by our perseverance. Explain the terms used here to describe our continuance in faith. What are we to learn in this? How can we continue in the faith and remain in the hope of the gospel in our fast-paced world?
