HR stuff. Strife at work seems inevitable. What are some areas in which employers and employees find themselves at odds, and how do things get worked out (if at all)?

Obey, v. 22. Are there times when workers do not obey bosses? Why?

Just & fair, v. 4:1. Paul tells masters to treat their slaves "justly and fairly." Consider what that admonition meant to them and what it means for us.

Work heartily, v. 23. We Christians are to work heartily in the ways we serve our "masters" and "servants". How does it affect our treatment of others when those we serve are also Christians, as well as when they are not?

Pay back, v. 25. There are consequences for those who fail to heed this counsel. What does this mean for us?

Reward, v. 24. God rewards obedience. How does knowing this affect our attitudes and behavior?

Choose to welcome these teachings and be receptive to the work of the Holy Spirit in your life as you live out their implications.
