Considerations for the week

In the past century, some have characterized Jesus as a mere moral teacher. How does this passage challenge their attempts?

v. 19. What does Jesus mean when He says the Son can do nothing by Himself?

v. 20. *The Father shows the Son all He does.* What does this teach us about the inner life of the Trinity?

v. 21+. The Father gives life. The Son gives life. Consider how these relate to each other, how they might be described as parallel, complementary, interdependent, duplicative, or something else altogether?

v. 22. *The Father has entrusted all judgment to the Son.* What does that mean of itself and as it relates to relationships within the Trinity?

v. 25+. How might it happen for us to hear the voice of the Son of God in the present tense?

v. 27+. How does Jesus' commitment to the Father's will shape His authority?

What did you do with Jesus Christ?

Please use these considerations for personal reflection, small group discussions, and with friends and family.
