Self-deception. Consider a time when someone convinced themselves that something was true when it was not the truth. When does this usually occur? What often results?

Reality check, v. 2. It can be difficult to stay on-course. How did Paul give himself a reality check? Consider the tools that are available to guard against self-deception.

Freedom in Christ, v. 3-4. Note the aim of the false brothers who spied on Paul. How is freedom taken away?

Legalism. Explain circumstances when legalism can be appealing.

How do people rely upon the law inappropriately, and what is the result?

Comment upon the struggle between cultural pressures and the truth of the gospel.

Concord, v. 7-10. The apostles reached agreement in service of Christ. How did it happen?

Choose now to accept their example to us as disputes arise in our body of believers.
