The Lord's Prayer:

Lead us not into temptation

Matthew 6:13

What is Jesus telling us to pray?

James 1:13; Matthew 4:1; Ephesians 6:12; James 1:14; Exodus 6:6

Why does Jesus want us to pray like this? Mark 9:28; 1 John 4:4; Matthew 7:11

What happens when we pray this prayer and God does not answer?

Plan twenty minutes alone with James 1:2-3:

Consider trials pure joy . . . the testing of your faith produces steadfastness.

Considerations for the week

Why is it important to pray that God won't lead us into temptation?

We are to be mindful of both our identity and God's identity. How can this help us in our battle against temptation and sin?

Review times when you yielded to temptation, and anticipate how you are likely to be tempted today. How does awareness of our past susceptibilities change the way we pray now?

Explain the place of preemptive prayer.

Having dealt with a particular temptation or sin, we like to think we become immune to its lure. Why it is dangerous to think this way?

Consider that having an inner conflict when tempted means that God has not given up on you. It means He is committed to making you more like Jesus. How does this perspective view temptation and your reaction it?

Please use these considerations for personal reflection, small group discussions, and with friends and family.

Being consciously attentive to the Spirit, write down everything that comes to mind. Maybe set a timer where you can't see it. When it seems as though you've written all you can, keep at it and continue as you let your mind wander and your spirit interact with the Word.

For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the cosmic powers over this present darkness, against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly places.
